- 3 You may qualify to participate if you are seeking **silicone gel breast implants** for breast reconstruction, augmentation, or revision surgery.


- 4 The study is also enrolling a control group of **300** women receiving other types of **aesthetic surgery**.

- 5 You will be required to sign an **informed consent** which explains what the study is and **your responsibilities** as a participant.


- 6 You will then need to complete a short **pre-surgery questionnaire** at your physician's office.


- 7 You will then be asked to complete an **online questionnaire every year for 10 years**. The questionnaire will take approximately 15 minutes of your time.

- 8 You will be paid for **completion of each questionnaire, including the pre-surgery questionnaire**.


- 9 The cost of the surgery and implants are **not covered by the study**.


- 10 Patients who are implanted with **MemoryGel® or MemoryShape®** implants will also receive the **Mentor Enhanced Warranty at no cost**. This includes reimbursement up to \$3500 to cover out of pocket **surgery costs for qualifying rupture, double capsule, late-forming seroma, and Grade III or IV capsular contracture events**.
